Harmony of Jesus' Resurrection

Mark 16:1-4

When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the *mother* of James, and Salome, bought spices, so that they might come and anoint Him.² Very early on the first day of the week, they came to the tomb when the sun had risen.³ They were saying to one another, "Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?" ⁴ Looking up, they saw that the stone had been rolled away, although it was extremely large.

Matt. 28:2-6

And behold, a severe earthquake had occurred, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled away the stone and sat upon it. ³ And his appearance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow. ⁴ The guards shook for fear of him and became like dead men. ⁵ The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid; for I know that you are looking for Jesus who has been crucified. ⁶ He is not here, for He has risen, just as He said. Come, see the place where He was lying."

Luke 24:3

but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.

Mark 16:4b

...they saw a young man sitting at the right, wearing a white robe; and they were amazed.

Luke 24:5a

and as the women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground...

Mark 16:6a

...he said to them, "Do not be amazed; you are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who has been crucified.

Luke 24:5b

Why do you seek the living One among the dead?

Mark 16:6b

He has risen; He is not here; behold, here is the place where they laid Him.

Luke 24:6b-8

Remember how He spoke to you while He was still in Galilee, ⁷saying that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again." ⁸ And they remembered His words,

Matthew 28:7

[And the angel said to them], "Go quickly and tell His disciples that He has risen from the dead; and behold, He is going ahead of you into Galilee, there you will see Him;

Mark 16:7b

just as He told you...

Matt. 28:7b

behold, I have told you."

Matt. 28:8a

And they left the tomb quickly with fear and great joy...

Mark 16:8b

for trembling and astonishment had gripped them; and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.

Matt. 28:8b

and [the women] ran to report it to His disciples...

Luke 24:9b

to the eleven and to all the rest.

Luke 24:10 Now they were Mary Magdalene and Joanna and Mary the *mother* of James; also the other women with them were telling these things to the apostles.
